PORTO RICO**[The organic act temporarily to provide revenues and civil government for Porto Rico was approved Apr. 12, 1900, and became effective May 1 1900. From that date to June 30, 1908, annual reports were made by the governor of Porto Rico to the State Department (S10.1:). Beginning with the fiscal year 1909, the governor reports to the War Department, in accordance with the act of July 15, 1909, promulgated by Executive order of same date. *See*, for text of Executive order and act, and for historical information, note under W75.]**S10.1:** Annual reports of governor
