## 135. SPECIAL AGENTS DIVISION

[Special agents of the Treasury Department have been employed and recognized by law almost from the organization of the Department. About 1870, judging from entries in the Official register (I 1.25:) and the Congressional directory (Y4.P93:1), a more definite organization seems to have been effected, as the Division of Special Agents, in the Office of the Secretary, under a supervising special agent.
