[May 29, IS30, the Senate adopted a motion directing "the Secretary of the Treasury to cause a comparison to be made of the standards of weight and measure used at the principal custom-houses of the United States, and to report to the Senate at the next session of Congress." Mar. 3, IS31, the Secretary of the Treasury reported that the work of comparing the standards of weight and measure was "commenced under the immediate superintendence of Mr. [Ferdinand Rudolph] Hassler," giving an account of what had been done. Prof. Hassler, speaking of this work, says that he was engaged in the Treasury Department "in comparing the weights and measures used at the custom-houses of the United States, and ascertaining by experiment the proper hydrometer proofs of liquor." Such large discrepancies were found in the standards of weight and measure that the Secretary of the Treasury directed that standards be adopted by the Treasury Department, and that copies be made and distributed to the various custom-houses. Congress, by joint resolution approved June 14, IS36, ordered that the Treasury Department should furnish each State with copies of these standards, and by act approved July 7, IS38, it was provided that the Secretary of the Treasury cause to be made under the superintendence of Mr. Hassler one standard balance for each State. By joint resolution approved July 27, IS65, a set of standard weights and measures of the metric system was ordered to be delivered to the governor of each State. By joint resolution approved Mar. 3, IS81, it was provided that a complete set of all the weights and measures adopted as standards should be delivered by the Secretary of the Treasury to the governor of each State for the use of agricultura colleges in the States, respectively, which have received a grant of land from the United States, and one set of the same to the Smithsonian Institution. In act approved Mar. 3, IS73, an appropriation was made for "standard weights and measures." In alt approved June 20, IS78, "Standard Weights and National Bureau of Standards.
