                                          The regular set of Army registers, as listed below, contains names of officers of Army, with record of service, rank, etc. The earliest registers appeared with slight variations in title, but since 1818 the title has read Official army register. 1813-38, Army registers for almost all years are found in American state papers, class 5, Military affairs, v. 1-7 (016-022). From 1819, for a number of years, there was usually but one issue a year, that being with a few exceptions in January. To supply the need for revised information between the annual issues, private prints, usually somewhat differently arranged, were issued for several years between 1835 and 1844, several by Benjamin Homans being entered in the list below. From 1846 to 1869 there were usually two official editions a year. Since 1870, there has been but one issue a year, but from 1891 this has been supplemented by the Army list and directory (W3.10:).

Prior to 1896, the annual issues of the Army register did not appear in the Congressional set. A report dated Nov. 18, 1818, showing number and grade of officers of Army, where stationed, number on duty, and those on furlough, was printed as 15th Congress, 2d session, House document 3, serial no. 17. From 1848 to 1860, transcripts of the official list, showing pay and allowances for each officer, were prepared by fiscal years, usually from the register issued the preceding January, with necessary corrections for deaths, resignations, etc. These appear in the Congressional set only, as follows:

# W4. CHICKAMAUGA AND CHATTANOOGA NATIONAL MILITARY PARK COMMISSION

By act approved Aug. 19, 1890, \$125,000 was appropriated for the condemnation and purchase of the land rendered historic by the battles of Chattanooga and Chickamauga, and a commission was authorized to take up the work of converting the land into a national military park.
