The Department of Justice organized a small force of special agents of its own because the sundry civil appropriation act, approved May 27, 1908, prohibited the further use by the Department of Justice, of the Treasury Department secret service force.

The title of the chief in charge is Chief Examiner, who is also authorized to be Chief of the Bureau of Investigation.]
