

## LC. LIBRARY OF CONGRESS

[The Library of Congress, first established by the act of Apr. 24, 1800, was partially destroyed in 1814 when the British fired the Capitol. By the act of Jan. 30, 1815, the library of Thomas Jefferson was purchased by the Government, and this collection formed the basis of the present national library.
